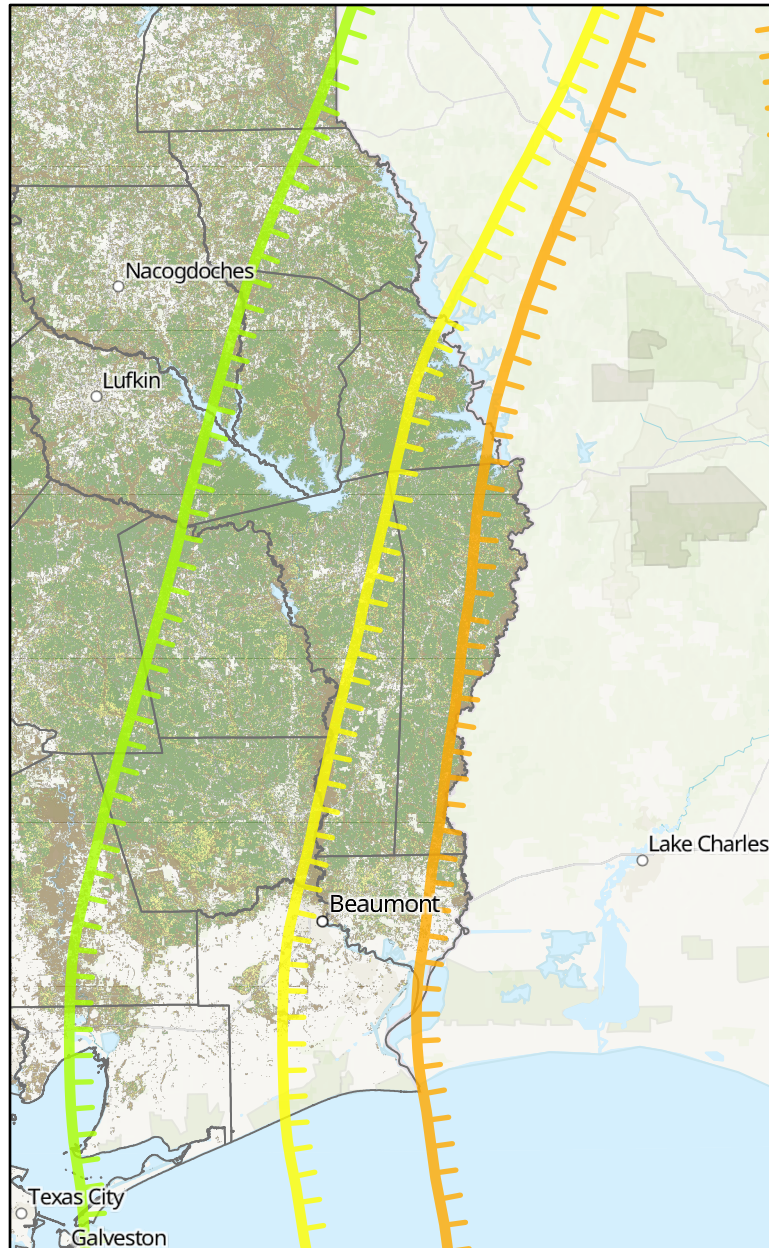


Hurricane Laura

Hurricane Laura made landfall in the early hours of August 27, 2020, at Cameron, Louisiana, as a Category-4 hurricane, soon slowing to a Category-2. Hurricane-force winds (Category-1) swept through a small portion of the eastern edge of East Texas, with tropical storm-force winds extending somewhat farther into East Texas. Field reports indicate minimal timber damage.
